He has customers that come from all over the city so it only made sense that he move to an area that is more centrally located for everyone to get to. He is a conservation framer so everything he does is of the highest quality, he only uses acid free materials and UV alass. Joseph's background in the fine art business has led him to be known for carrying high quality investment grade art. It's not uncommon for them to have a \$10k piece of art on the wall and an original Thomas Hart Benton being framed. They absolutely love Englewood Station Arts District.
