Englewood Theater & Ben Franklin to be Purchased



The historic Englewood Theater and adjacent Ben Franklin store will be purchased by a newly formed Missouri non-profit.

Friends of Englewood Theater have signed a real estate contract to acquire the two properties from the estate of Wade Williams II, who owned the two properties which anchor the south side of the Englewood Arts District.

The Englewood Arts District has seen a resurgence in the past decade through the efforts of local business owners and the opening of the Englewood Arts Center. Englewood Arts is not directly involved in the transaction.

"Our immediate plans were to acquire the two properties, work on financing the purchases and slowly figure out the adaptive reuse of the two buildings," said Brent Schondelmeyer, president of Friends of Englewood Theater.

This is a grass roots community movement with business owners in the District, and area patrons wanting to see this transformation.

This is the first step in a long journey to restore these beloved spaces and breathe new life into the Englewood Arts District! WHAT'S NEXT:

- Secure financing and finalize the purchase
- Work to list the Englewood Theater on the National Register of Historic Places
- Complete a feasibility study for future uses of the buildings
