Artists Palette - Andrew Batcheller

Andrew Batcheller, a Kansas City native who has called Joplin, MO his home for the last decade, classifies his work a "portraiture" using birds as analogies for the human condition. The emotional quality of his work evokes thoughtful contemplation of our own human drama. His paintings are part of national and international collections.

Working in oils on linen, in his little converted corner market he converted into his studio, he spend all of his days creating. Andrew uses birds and other wild creatures as stand-ins for us humans when speaking of

and about the human condition. He finds that the faces of animals can absolutely translate all of the emotions we tend to attribute only to our species. The eyes can show fear, the mouths and beaks of birds can convey a smile and a frown. Andrew feels that this is a cleaner slate to begin with when telling his narrative.









Andrew's inspiration for his work comes from everywhere! Current events, emotional moments in life and even a story from a stranger. Often the subject he likes to discuss in his work is tragic or sad or just difficult. But his one true goal is always to find the beauty in the ugliness. It is hidden sometimes but he focuses on a way to find that silver lining that is inevitably there. It has been a rewarding search and his life is one he would have never dreamed of. He often says he's the happiest man in all of Joplin.

Andrew is currently selling his amazing paintings in the Kansas City area out of the WiNc Inclusion Center, 10910 E Winner Rd., in the Englewood Arts District. He will be showing there until the end of March.
