Green Dog Gallery has several artists and has daily operating hours.

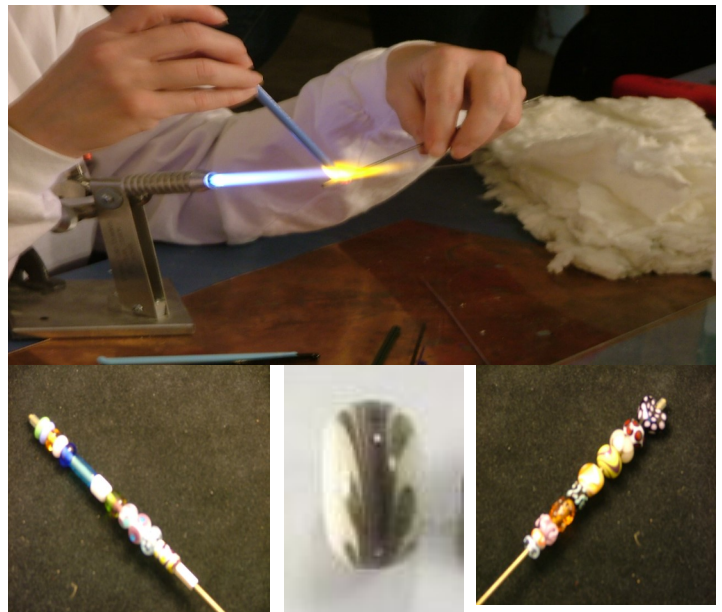

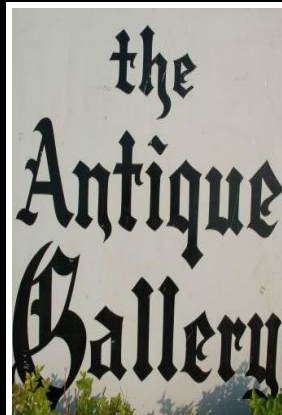

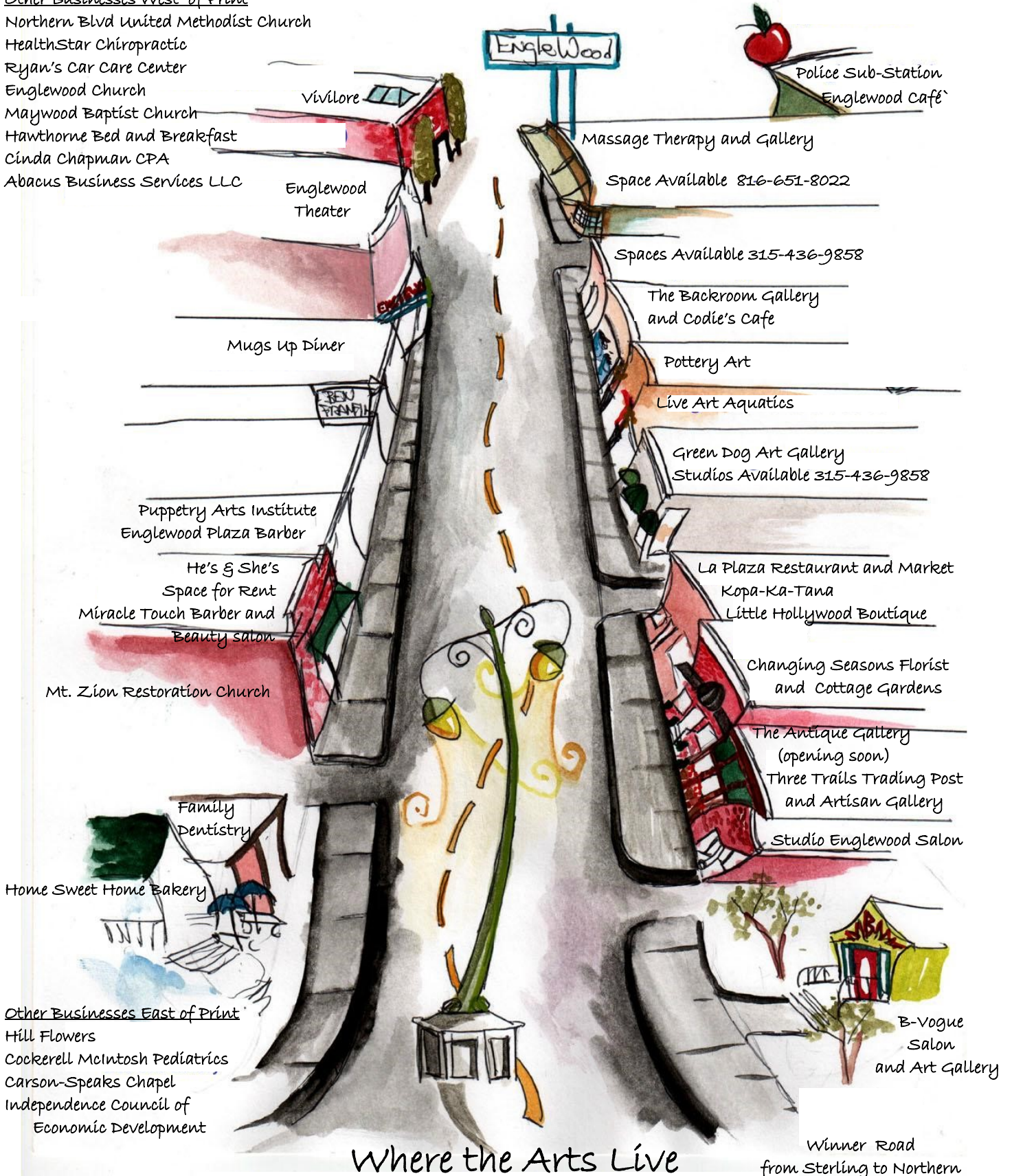
