Grand Opening of the WiNc Inclusion Center & Independence Pride Flag Dedication

Join the Grand Opening of the WiNc Inclusion Center, 10910 E Winner Rd, here in the Arts District, and dedication of the Independence Pride Flag by Mayor Eileen Weir on 3rd Friday, Feb 17, 2023. Doors open at 4:30pm. Ribbon cutting by the Independence Chamber of Commerce starts at 5pm. Celebrate Independence Pride Flag dedication with most recent past Mayor, Mrs. Eileen Weir and meet their featured artist Andrew Batcheller.

The **WiNc Inclusion Center** supports and serves the LGBTQ+ Community of Independence, MO, and greater Jackson County area by providing a #SAFESPACE. A positive, inclusive environment for those who identify as LGBTQ+ and their families to commune, socialize and learn-where they are able to be comfortably open about their sexual orientation or gender identity, where and when it feels appropriate to them.

Their goal is to become a host space for programming and activities focused on mentoring LGBTQ+ youth and community members in the areas of life and job skills, leadership, business skills, and entrepreneurship. Activities are funded by revenue from our bookstore retail experience, event ticket sales, community donations, corporate and Patreon sponsorships and government and corporate grants and sponsorships.

West iNd Connection (WiNc) was established to create a safe and progressive community for all to live, work, play and visit. Their aim to create a positive progressive culture and strengthen awareness for all members of our city through arts programs, neighborhood initiatives, and public events. Mayor Mrs. Eileen Weir served two terms as mayor of Independence from 2014 -2022. She served as 4th District Council representative from 2012-2014. Mayor Weir was the city's 50th mayor and second female mayor. In June of 2018, Mayor Eileen Weir raised the Independence Pride Flag at the Independence City Hall. It flew for 19 days before the Independence City Council rejected a proposal by the city's mayor to fly the rainbow flag at municipal buildings during LGBTQ pride month in June. Mayor Eileen Weir said flying the flag would show the city values diversity and inclusion and would make LGBTQ people feel welcome and safe there. She said the flag is a "powerful symbol" when it comes to making LGBTQ people feel safe in the city.



Sunday, February 19, 4 - 7 PM **Ukulele Fight Club** jam session. All are invited and welcome to just hang out and listen or join in and play.




