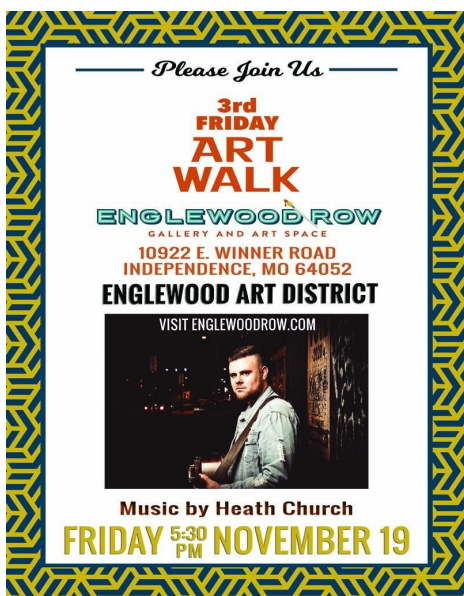

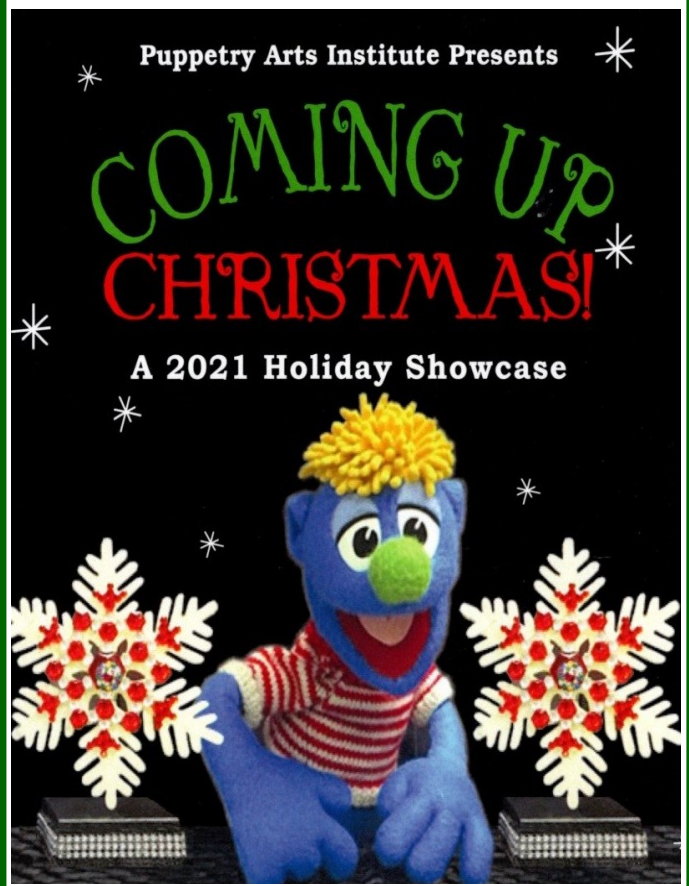

Northern Blvd United Methodist Church

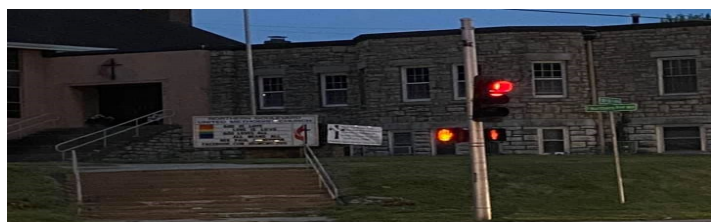
100th Year Anniversary Service, Sunday, December 12, 10:30 AM.

On December 4, 1921, builders laid the cornerstone for the present location, 1800 S Northern Boulevard. The box which was set in the cornerstone contained a Bible, a Book of Discipline, a roster of members and officers, a list of those who were contributing to the building fund, copies of Christian Advocate, The Examiner, The Kansas City Star, and Englewood local items.

This December the church community takes time to remember the history as a church, and as members of the Independence community. Just think of what that cornerstone, the building, and the people of Northern Boulevard have experienced and witnessed in 100 years!

In honor of the 100th Anniversary, they are doing a **Children's Book collection** for some of the local organizations caring for women and their children. While the church originated in 1889, with a small group of people at various locations, it wasn't until 1921 that plans were made for a more modern structure to accommodate the growth in membership.

Please join the Church Community to learn about the unique local history wrapped up in the Northern Boulevard United Methodist Church building and congregation. Independence City Council woman, Karen DeLuccie will be presenting a proclamation recognizing NBUMC's 100th anniversary. Come and Join the Church Service, Sunday, December 12, 10:30 AM, at 1800 S Northern Blvd. Parking lot is on the west side of Church entrance to the lot is at 18th and Hedges.

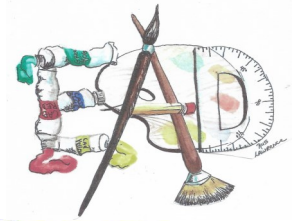

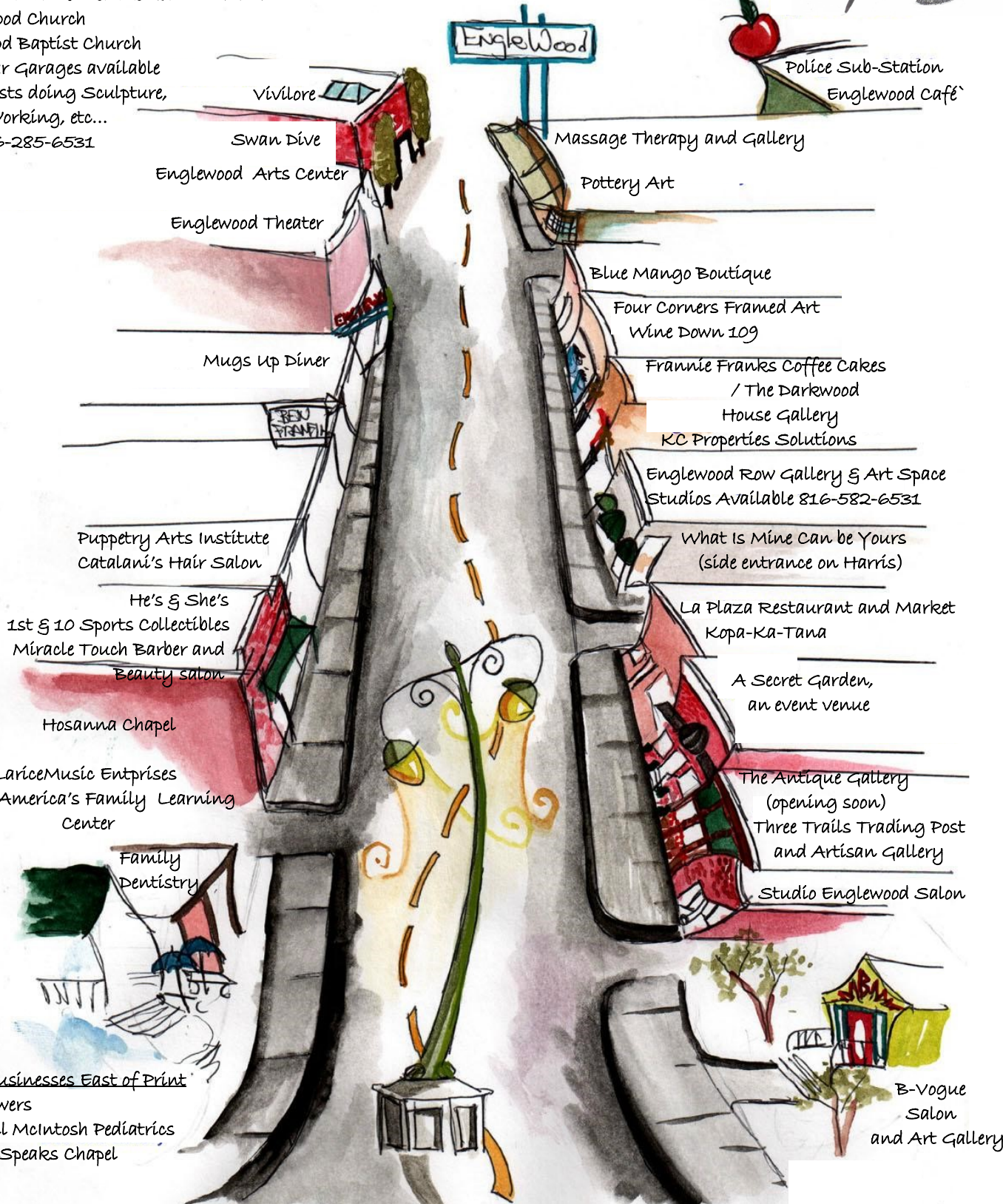
