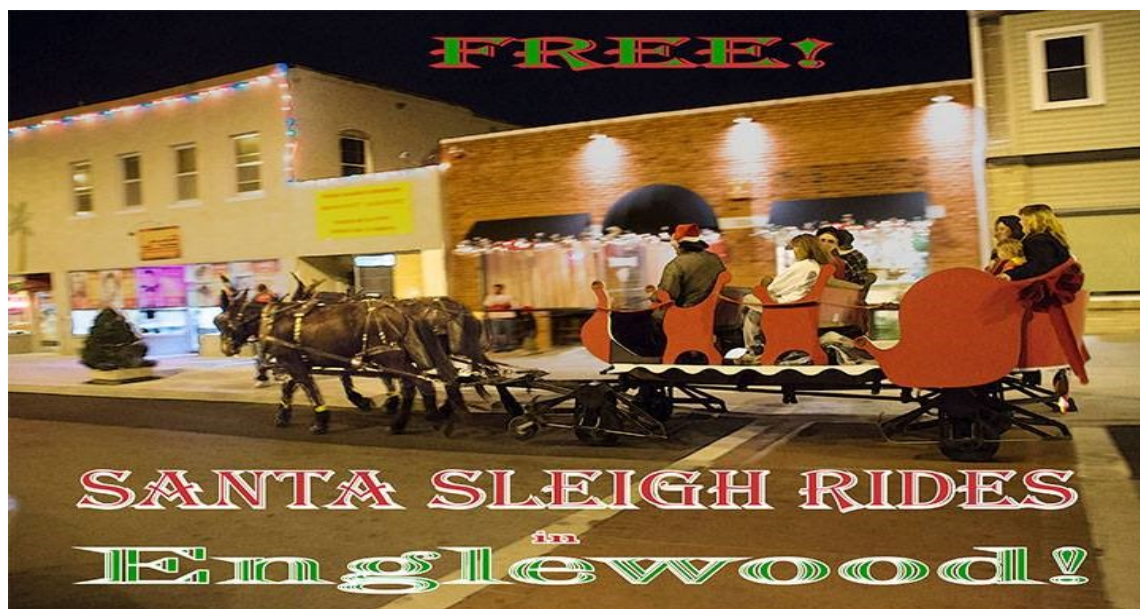

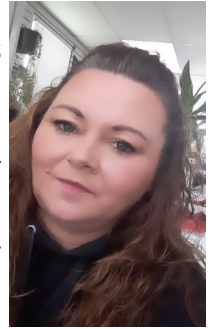

73-Productions, Event Planning Services has come to Englewood! Noelle Davis is the owner and primary coordinator and has been coordinating events for 15 years. Here is part of her story and how 73-Productions Event Planning Services got their start and how you can find them in Englewood.

Like many great things in life, 73-Productions began as a dream, a powerful and impassable dream. She had been the event coordinator for her church and over a span of 10 years planned events ranging from children's productions and youth missions trips, to weddings and private parties. She wrote curriculum, coordinated Vacation Bible School for 100 children, and planned trips across country for 30 teenagers. But when someone asked her, "Why aren't you doing this for a living?", she was stumped. She thought she was doing it for a living! Noelle realized that the person wanted to know was why she wasn't doing it as a business. It actually had never occurred to Noelle that she could be a business owner or to do the thing she loved without the umbrella of the church. Once it became an idea it became a dream. Then, the dream became reality.

73-Productions, Event Planning Services began with themed events, like a murder mystery steampunk party for teenagers, an Alice in Wonderland bridal tea party, Valentine's tea parties for widows and Halloween parties...so many Halloween parties! In 2016, Noelle was asked to coordinate the wedding of a friend's daughter and that changed the trajectory of her business model. Turns out, she loved a good wedding as much as she loved to wear costumes. In order to learn the ropes of the KC Wedding Industry, she went to work for a local wedding venue and winery. There, she met some of the best vendors in the business and watched tons of brides and grooms say, "I do!". She learned the ropes from the venue side, and continued to coordinate events and weddings on her own. She also had the freedom to plan

some themed events that she was very proud of like, Eggs After Dark which is an adult glow-in-the-dark egg hunt, as well as Wine and Pride, a drag show with local performers to commemorate Pride Month.



In 2019 Noelle met Scott Cauer who asked her to come to Englewood Station and see what was happening in the Arts District. Much like Alice looking through the keyhole, she knew she was seeing a small portion of what the area would become when the doors of Englewood Row Gallery and Art Space was opened. The more she was around and the more neighbors she meet, the more she love Englewood. Noelle quickly grabbed some of her favorite wedding vendors and planned an art deco photo shoot right down the middle of the street! There is



such a buzz and hum in the air. She met a gentleman who was walking down the sidewalk during Chalk the Walk who said to her, "This place has good bones. I feel like I could belong here".

That is the feeling that Noelle has and why she has chosen to collaborate with the Englewood Row Gallery and Art Space to make Englewood Station the home for 73-Productions, Event Planning Services. Noelle hopes to meet everyone on the block and get the opportunity to plan events with them all in



the neighborhood and surrounding areas. Prior to concentrating on motion picture and television performances, Michael actively concentrated on solo work, and had performed in numerous Manhattan clubs and cabarets.
