Featured artist of the month at Englewood Row Gallery and Art Space is Robin Rice is a very parotitic gal she grew up in Liberty and



has lived here in Independence for 27 years. She has been drawing and painting most of her life. Using acrylics and watercolor upon occasion to create art, the medium she prefers is pen and ink. The technique is called pointillism or stippling for short.

Robin blends different colored dots to create texture, depth, and shape. Her inspiration is based on George Pierre Seurat, the father of pointillism.



Previously Robin has shown in the Crossroads Arts District, the West Bottoms, City Market Coffee, and the Englewood Arts District. She has participated in the KCPT auction several being awarded honorable mention and even an overbid! Robin a graduate of the University of Central Missouri with a BS in Art education. She is semi-retired after 24 years in the Kansas City Public Schools. Currently she teaches 2 days a week at a private school.
