12th Anniversary of the 3rd Friday Art Walks Englewood Arts District

Twelve years of Art walks! The first, 3rd Friday Art Walk at Englewood Arts District was two years before we were the "Arts District" which was ten years ago this month! Englewood attained "Arts District" distinction September 19, 2011. Happy Anniversaries Englewood!

Russ Lawrence, creator and original owner and artist of the Green Dog Gallery and Changing Seasons, had a vision after attending one of the Crossroads, First Fridays events. That first 3rd Friday the venues that participated were Changing Seasons, Winner Road Gallery, Green Dog Gallery, Stonebridge Café, Puppetry Arts Institute, and B-Vogue Salon and Gallery! In the months to come, twelve years ago, the additions of Frick Gallery, and Three Trails Trading Post added into the monthly 3rd Friday Art Walk events. 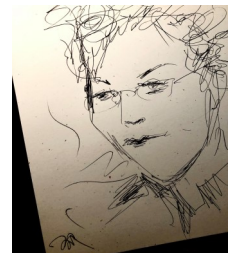

Puppetry Arts Institute will be open for the Art walk with their Bicentennial Tour, terrific displays and puppets!

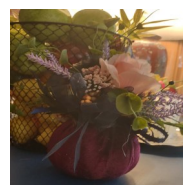

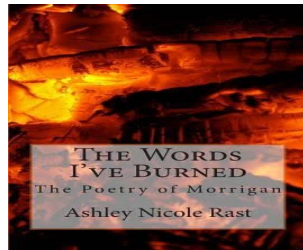

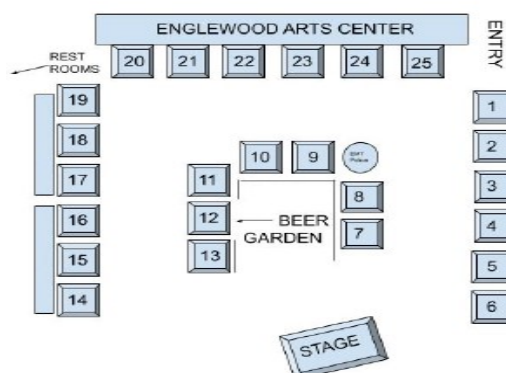

Four Corners Framed Art is hosting an in-person meet and greet with legendary rock and roll photographer **Mike Frankel** on 3rd Friday, Oct. 15, 5 pm to 9 pm so "Save the Date". Free event & open to the public. During the late 1960s, Frankel was one of the most in demand photographers for mu-



sicians. The great photographer Jim Marshall, who had extended access to numerous musicians throughout the 1960s like Frankel, was once quoted saying, "Mike Frankel is the greatest rock and roll photographer of all time!" Frankel's archive of over 50,000 images is just being released to the public in a limited quantity. His first coffee table book is also set to be released by the end of 2021, followed by an additional book of just his Beatles photos. "This is truly a rare opportunity to meet a living legend," said Joseph Crownover. "This will be only the third time Mike Frankel's work has ever been shown or made available to the public since the photos were taken over 50 years ago."

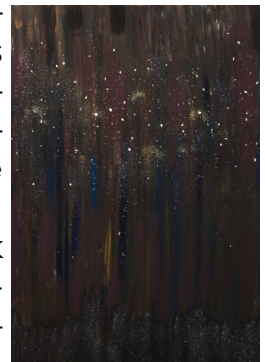

Many of her pieces are large and provide an excellent focal point for upscale businesses as well as homes.

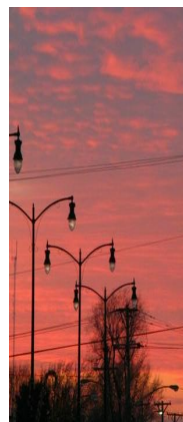


These works are truly an in-person experience, as many of them have metallic and other textural elements that simply can't be captured by a camera.

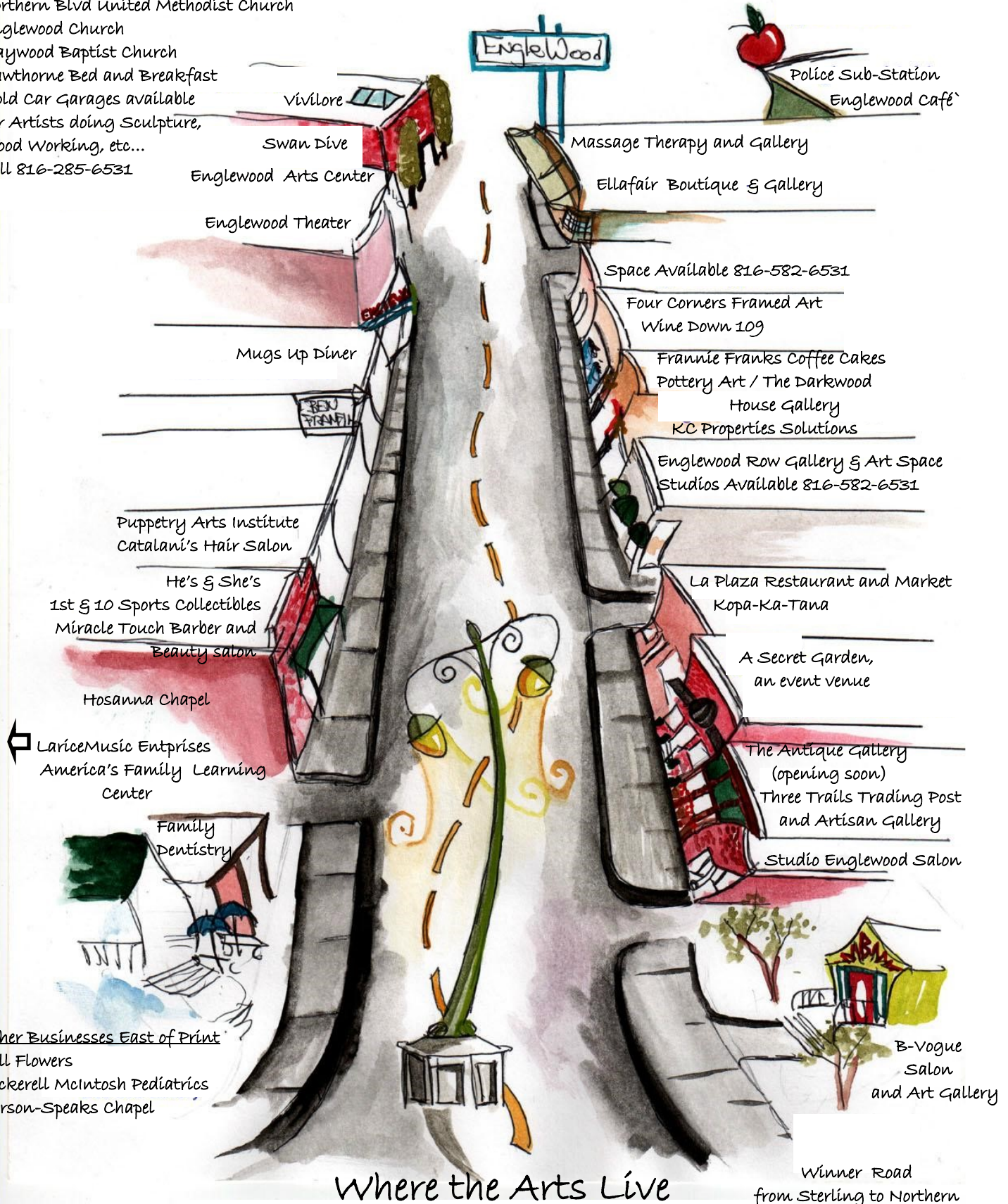
