

During the late 1960s, Frankel was one of the most in demand photographers for musicians. The great photographer Jim Marshall, who had extended access to numerous musicians throughout the 1960s like Frankel, was once quoted saying, "Mike Frankel is the greatest rock and roll photographer of all time!" Frankel's archive of over 50,000 images is just being released to the public in a limited quantity. His first coffee table book is also set to be released by the end of 2021, followed by an additional book of just his Beatles photos. "This is truly a rare opportunity to meet a living legend," said Joseph Crownover. "This will be only the third time Mike Frankel's work has ever been shown or made available to the public since the photos were taken over 50 years ago."
