is a great way for children, ages 7-12, to experience firsthand the power of art-making while learning a variety of new things. Each week is associated with a different theme. Classes per week cost \$245 with an additional \$75 for lunch (optional).

### **Session 1: June 5-9. Performance Week**

- During performance week, students will receive a one of a kind experience working with professional theatre artists as they learn the basics of Shakespearean history and acting techniques.

### **Session 2: June 12 -16. All About Animals**

- During all about animals week, we will be exploring the animal kingdom through drawing, painting, and sculpting. We get to talk with experts about wildlife and learn everything we can about our favorite animals and even some we never hear of.

### **Session 3: June 19- 23. Archeology Week**

Learn about the past while excavating and examining minerals, found objects and hand made objects. We will be building out own excavation sites on our own and having fun learning about ancient cultures.

### **Session 4: June 26- 30, Sea Life Week**

will explore the depths of the ocean and find all kinds of creatures to draw inspiration from. We will recreate living creatures in painting or sculpting and even making up our own sea life.

### **Session 5: July 3- 7, Plants, Bugs and Birds Week**

From the smallest seeds to the largest trees we will have fun exploring Nature. We can sculpt bugs, use flowers and leaves as painting tools and then add them to a beautiful collage as we learn more about the world around us.

## Scholarships Available!

**Session 6- July 10- 14, In Food Week** we will be looking at the artistic side of food and using it to make art. We can have fun reimagining our favorite snacks through sculpting and paintings.

**Session 7- July 17- 21, Build it, Sculpt it Week** This week is focused on 3-D art making, we want to make large sculptures, group projects and unique creations with cardboard, clay, plaster and more!

**Session 8- July 24-28, S.T.E.A.M. Week** Science & Technology, interpreted through Engineering and the Arts based in Mathematics. We will use creative problem solving and art to make kinetic sculptures, while learning to make primitive robots and more!

### **Teen Experience- June 12-16 Sculpture for Teens or July 17 - 21 Painting for Teens.**

The Teen Experience classes are structured for more in-depth learning and exploration of a type of medium or artistic style with each class being a **Half Day** for a full week. Classes cost **\$150** for the Week. This year we will be offering 2 different focuses, Sculpture and Painting. In the **Sculpture Experience** we will be focusing on clay and found object sculptures. In the **Painting Experience** we will be focusing on watercolor and acrylic images.

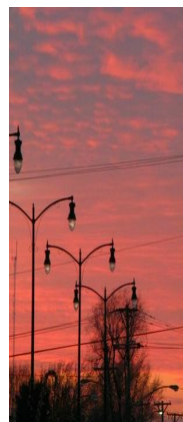

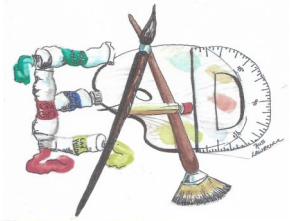

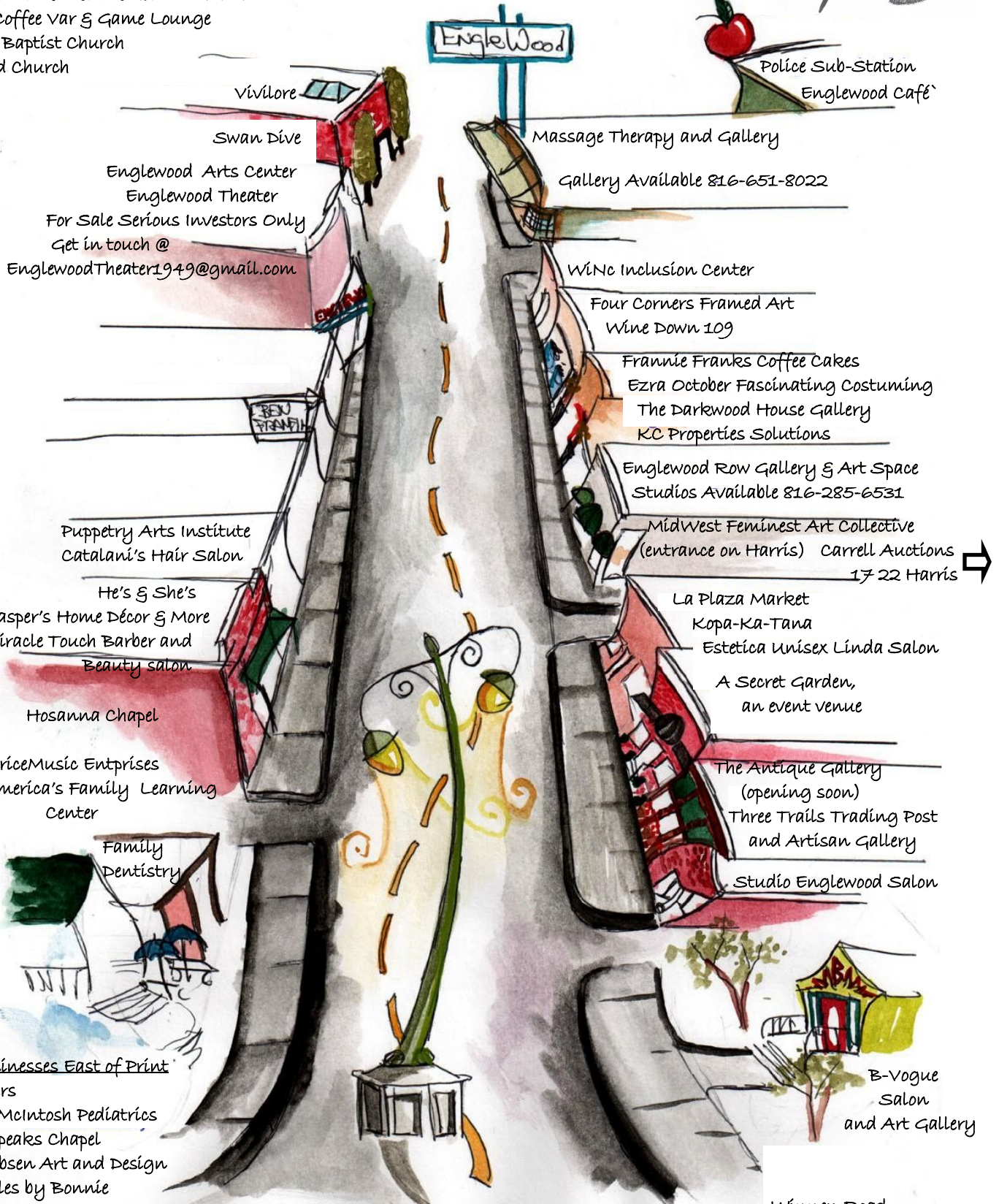
