is a great way for children, ages 7-12, to experience firsthand the power of art-making while learning a variety of new things. Each week is associated with a different theme. Classes per week cost \$245 with an additional \$75 for lunch (optional).

Session 1: June 5-9. Performance Week -During performance week, students will receive a one of a kind experience working with professional theatre artists as they learn the basics of Shakespearean history and acting techniques.

Session 2: June 12 -16. All About Animals -During all about animals week, we will be exploring the animal kingdom through drawing, painting, and sculpting. We get to talk with experts about wildlife and learn everything we can about our favorite animals and even some we never hear of.
