Englewood Arts is here!



On Monday, February 10, 3:45 PM there was a key hand off ceremony from the City of Independence to the new owners of the old CMH building, to now be known as, the Englewood Arts Center. This new initiative coming to Independence will be using the Arts as a catalyst for community improvement.

A newly formed non-profit called Englewood Arts has taken form in the historic Englewood Station Arts District. The two-prong organization is focused on thee Arts; visual, preforming & culinary, and affordable sustainable housing.

On October 7, 2019, the Independence City Council gave unanimous vote to sell the three-story building located at 10901 E Winner Rd. to Englewood Arts for its new art center. The arts center will be finished out with flexibility in mind giving it the ability to respond quickly to the needs and interest of the community. "We want to do something different that has not been done before while fulfilling the needs of artists and the community that is already in place" says Director Michael Baxley. Initial programing for the center will include glass, painting, murals, ceramics, wood neon, preforming and culinary arts.

The arts building is only the first phase of several. Englewood Arts is simultaneously working on strategic housing plan that addresses gentrification in the earliest stages of the development. The housing plan, along with a zoning overlay, will attract artists and educators to the area while preserving and giving opportunities to the residents that are already in place. Increasing housing density and homeownership is just part of the mission. Recently Englewood Arts adopted the mantra: "Community profit, not financial profit is the objective! Come join us!" Progress is underway with a goal to have portions of the arts center open to the public before the end of 2020.

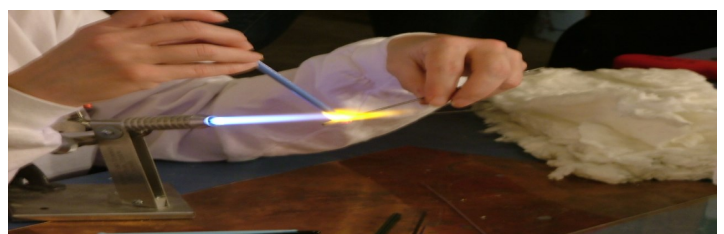

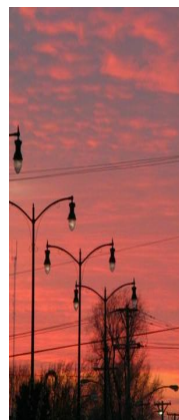

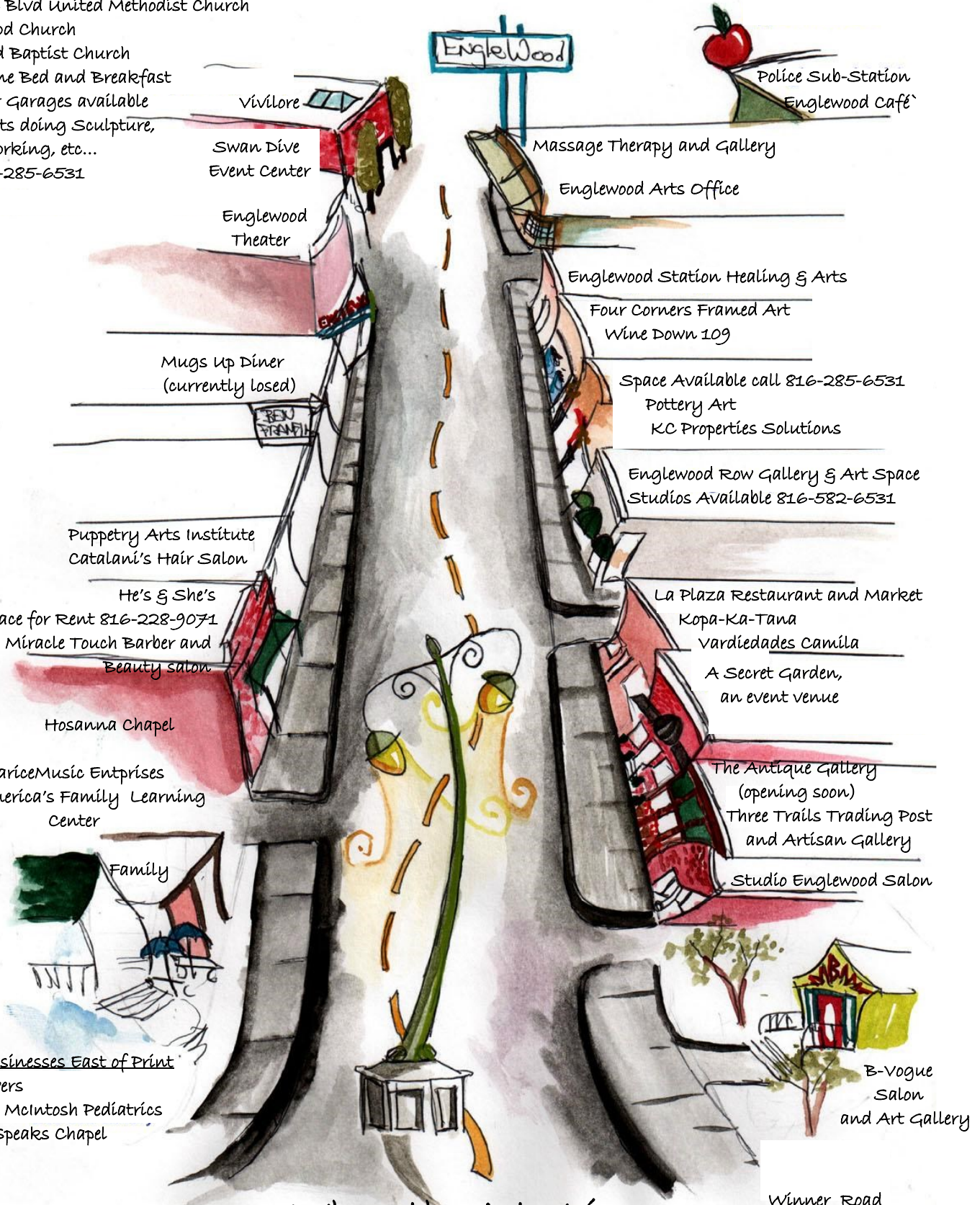
