New Business Opened July Inkwell Café

Inkwell Café is a project by Esoterica KC; a budding company in the Independence area, that plans to expand beyond their current location. Esoterica was founded by Trevor Banhart, along with his partners



Jacob Savage and Doug Jenkins. Preparations for the grand opening of Inkwell Café began approximately six months before the official opening date, July 1st. In preparation for opening, the café space

was completely remodeled and reorganized. The dining room was opened up by lowering a wall and rebuilding the kitchen. They now have two separate dining areas; the front with tables and chairs for dining and the rear features bar seating along with armchairs and couches for lounging and conversation. From the beginning, they have strongly focused on the traditional preparation of coffee.

Their traditional preparation of coffee is based on the Specialty Coffee Association (SCA) guidelines. This means that they use extremely precise measurements when making their coffee and specialty drinks. It is this attention to detail that makes their café an up and coming staple in the Englewood Station Arts District and gives them the ability to grow as a company in the KC area. This traditional work gives them an enjoyable atmosphere and adds a personal touch to each drink they prepare. They plan to grow beyond their current venue, as they venture and expand into other influential areas of Kansas City.

The goal of Esoterica KC is to grow a community in coffee and to help local businesses blossom. They chose to start in the historic Englewood Station Arts District, due to the high volume of art and strong sense of community. To establish their presence in the community, they also display and sell local art in their café and play host to live music every week on Saturdays. Inkwell café also provides a catering service available in KC; primarily for the Art Walks presented by Englewood Row Gallery and Art Space. They recently added food to their growing menu and currently feature a variety of breakfast and baked goods.

Weather it's a quick stop on the way to work, a destination to spend time with friends, or a Saturday night of music and fun; the consensus among the community rings loud and clear. An overwhelmingly positive reception on social media and Google of the little café has set the stage for a strong future for an incredible community. The owners only hope that they can continue to see it grow.
